The meeting started at 10:37 a.m. (PDT).

Old Business:

- ACEP Sports Medicine Section Meeting Minutes from ACEP21 Approval
- Council Meeting Report: Final resolution outcomes were pending. See attached Council Report for outcomes from all resolutions.
- EMRA Sports Medicine Section Updates (Tyson/Jasmin):
 - o Working on sports equipment removal educational pamphlets and simulations. Katie pointed out that CORD has equipment removal modules in sports medicine curriculum. <https://www.cordem.org/resources/education--curricula/curricular-toolkit/sports-medicine/>. Finding ways for section members can help with this.
 - o Updating fellowship match website to reflect EM friendly programs (<https://www.acep.org/sportsmedicine/mentorship-program/map-of-sports-medicine-fellowships/>). Ross has fellowship survey data from last year, will update ACEP fellowship map for EMRA to refer to.
- ACEP22 Scientific Assembly Presentations/ACP23 Scientific Assembly
 - o Drs. Hwang, Garrett, Hogrefe, Perron, and Levine gave talks at the ACEP22 Scientific Assembly.
 - o Dr. Garrett is in charge of ortho/sports medicine curriculum for ACEP. If you want to give a talk, submit your talk proposal through the ACEP website. If you have something you want to hear, please let her know. ACEP23 course proposals due November 11th, 2022 (<https://www.acep.org/meetings-events/courseproposal>)
 - o Additional discussion on how to get invited to speak at ACEP: multiple factors go into selection, length/content. CME requirements for certain topics (opiates, trauma, etc) mean certain amount of hours dedicated to that topic. Fewer hours have been allocated for ortho/sports next year than this year. Some topics are cycled so not every topic is covered every year. Look at what has been done the past few years for topics that could be brought back. ¼ of speakers will be replaced for next year. Remember that these talks are aimed towards the general EM community, not sports specific.
 - o Dr. Feden pointed out that the new speaker's forum/drop the mic competition is a good opportunity to get your foot in the door and do a quick talk on a sports medicine topic.

Keep an eye out for solicitations over the summer. Dr. Mathiasen will send a reminder when submissions open up.

- AMSSM 2023 annual meeting involvement
 - o ICL deadline already passed. Dr. Mathiasen will send email to see if anyone is on the program planning committee or giving talks at AMSSM.
- Section Updates
 - o Dr. Sandy Schneider was interim liaison for the section and is now the ongoing liaison.
 - o Finances: We as a section have money. 15% of dues need to be spent in fiscal year or lost forever. Cannot be spent on food/drinks. Need to spend money by June 30. Some ideas: Gear, help med students/residents attend social outing, Section grant for sports medicine community involvement event.
 - o ACEP23 Program chair wants to do a boot camp fitness type session next year. SM section may organize some kind of sport related activity. 7x7 flag football?
 - o ACEP23 dates: 10/9-10/12/2023. Will try not to overlap section meeting with section-related topics, but not always possible.
- Collaboration with other sections (eg, Disaster or Event Medicine)
 - o Joint meetings/events was suggested. Discussed reserving 30 minutes of next meeting to discuss mass event coverage like medical director of marathon and invite event medicine section.
- NATA collaboration
 - o Not much movement due to covid, but they are ready to reengage. Potential speaking opportunities at their national meeting. Dr. Mathiasen will reach back out to them to discuss future collaborations. If you have ideas, let him know.

New Business

- EM-SM research network development: Multi center orthopedic outcome research network proposed by Dr. Hogrefe. If you are interested in participating in looking at some of these topics (occult scaphoid fractures, diagnosis of flexor tenosynovitis) let Dr. Hogrefe know.
- Scheduled section virtual meetings in January and July annually. Will announce dates in advance. Tentatively 5p PT/8p ET
- Section meeting sponsorship
 - o Discussion on whether the sports medicine section would accept sponsorships. Previously declined due to potential conflict of interest. Section voted to decline all sponsorships at present time.
- Section funds continued. Will discuss use of funds at virtual meeting in January, prior to end of fiscal year and again at beginning of fiscal year in July.
 - o Dr. Hogrefe planning to apply for section grant.
- Website maintenance and bulletin updates
 - o Some great content on the section website: MSK exam video series, interesting case posts
 - o Will aim to have new cases posted every month. If interested, submit case by the 20th of the month for editing.
 - o Quarterly bulletin will direct readers to website where we will have messages from section leadership and papers of interest to section membership.
 - o Wild Ortho Wednesdays by Dr. Denq is another place to submit cases.
- Database of Sports Medicine/Orthopaedic speakers
 - o Organized by Drs. Denq and Kiel, contact them to get in the database.
 - o Accessible to meeting planning committees, residencies, fellowships, etc. Includes contact information and areas of particular expertise
- AMSSM S.M.A.R.T.-E.S.T. workshop
 - o Usually run by FM trained people. There are a couple of EM based hands-on workshops on sideline emergencies, HEENT, hypo/hyperthermia, cardiac arrest. Proposal to add

section on mass casualty incidents within the EM workshop. If you are interested in contributing to this or thoracic/abdominal trauma management, let Drs. Mathiasen and Hogrefe know.

 - o Send suggestions to Drs. Hogrefe and Mathiasen. Will discuss further in July virtual meeting
- ACEP23 keynote speakers
 - o Send suggestions to Dr. Mathiasen. Rediscuss in January meeting.
